Stephen Arthur Lundin



October 19, 1952 - September 1, 2022

It is with profound sadness I inform the reader of the passing of Steve Lundin. Steve is survived by his wife of 42 years, Mary Jane, children Jeffrey and Abigail, daughter-in-law Kacey, son-in-law Mike, and grandchildren Arthur, Penelope, Taylor, and Blake.

Steve graduated from UC Berkeley in 1974. At Cal, he served as the president of our chapter, where he made best friends that traveled with him to Giants Spring Training for over 20 years. A devoted Cal football fan, he tailgated for every Cal home game, and celebrated 50 consecutive Big Games with a Cal win against Stanford!


Steve raised \$200 million during his career in philanthropy for the organizations he served. Starting at the UC Berkeley development office, he eventually became the President and CEO of the Alta Bates Summit Medical Foundation, and then in the same capacity at Adventist Health St. Helena Medical Foundation.

Towards the end of his cancer battle, when asked if he was at peace with his fate, he answered, "I lived a damn good life." May we all take inspiration from Steve's perspective.

Robert Bruce Roche



October 31, 1922 - August 23, 2022

Robert "Bob" Bruce Roche was raised in St. Francis Wood, San Francisco. He studied Electrical Engineering at UC Berkeley and was the Eminent Commander of our chapter.

He was on both the swim and water polo teams - the Polobears defeating rivals Stanford for the coveted title of Pacific Coast Champions.

Graduating in 1954, he married his college sweetheart Sally Floyd. After his time in the army and the Pacific Telephone Company, he started Roche Construction.

Bob was a Co-founder and Chairman of the Lafayette Community Center Foundation, and Director and Treasurer of Habitat for Humanity. He was the president of the Sigma Nu Alumni Foundation. He was elected to the Lafayette City Council, serving as Mayor in 1979. He used his electrical engineering to open the San Francisco Academy, and his construction for the Rancho Milagro Orphange in Mexico.

Bob maintained friendships of eighty years, remaining close to his Beta Psi brothers. He loved traveling the world with Sally and friends. Most meaningful to Bob was time with family. Bob died peacefully at home in Walnut Creek on August 23, surrounded by love at the age of 89.

In lieu of flowers the family requests donations be sent to the <u>Alzheimer's Association</u> or <u>Habitat</u> for Humanity.



ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT: ADAM FOREST





I recently spoke to Beta Psi Alumnus and former Eminent Commander Adam Forest about his startup company, Launchparty. The company strives of be a social investment platform for GenZ founders to raise capital and for their peers to discover and invest in their favorite startups together. The launchparty team is very "Sigma Nu." Not only is its CEO Adam Forest, but the CTO (Jay Greenblatt) and Lead Developer (Devin Cox) are Beta Psi alumns and served terms as Lieutenant Commander.

Launchparty continues to grow at an astounding rate. The team went before a full committee of FINRA for their final interview and product demo following a three-month long review process. The team expects to hear good news regarding the final decision come later this month.

In terms of the product itself, Launchparty is in the process of finalizing a partnership with Savvi Legal to incorporate automated SPV structuring into the platform. The core product is already fully functional and meets all compliance requirements, as the team works towards adding differentiating solutions and features.

Launchparty has raised \$135K to date which helped them get through the entire regulatory review process and core product development. They are continuing to raise in order to run real pilot campaigns this late fall and winter, show market validation, and iterate on the product to achieve a path towards product market fit.
